Objects of the Club

The Objects of the Newcastle Ramblers Bushwalking Club are

To promote bushwalking, camping and related recreational activities, increase the knowledge of members of the art of safe bushwalking, develop leadership skills, foster an appreciation of our natural beauty and an ideal of the conservation of fauna and flora.

Life Membership

Life Membership of the Club may be conferred under these Guidelines in recognition of distinguished and long standing contributions to the Objects of the Club.

Criteria for Life Membership

In considering the contributions of a person nominated for Life Membership, the following criteria will be taken into account:

- the **period** of membership of the Club
- the **extent** of the contributions that have been made to the Club's objects
- the **quality** of the contributions that have been made to the Club's objects
- the **innovations** that have been made in furthering the Club's objects.

Procedure

Nomination of a person for Life Membership must be made by a Club member in writing, address the criteria above and be delivered to the Club President.

Self nomination will not be accepted and a person being the nominee shall not take part in the consideration of the nomination.

A nomination for Life Membership will be considered by the Club Committee of Management. The decision of the Committee will be final.

Life membership will not be awarded posthumously.

Benefits

Life members will be exempt from Club annual membership fees.
