Personal Accident - How to make a PA Claim

The injured person is to contact our Broker to obtain a PA claim form within 30 days of the date of the accident.

Personal Accident Policy – Critical Incident Debriefing

Please read the CID information on page 8 of the PA Placing Schedule and note the time limit of 72 hours in which your GP is to refer you to a specialist.

The Limit specified in the Schedule is \$5,000 any one event / any one person.

The actual Endorsement extends the cover beyond what we understood the cover to be in that the cover not only applies to persons who witness the incident but also to the person injured.

For a claim to eventuate it has to be a serious accident / incident which causes Injury to an Insured Person under the policy. A serious accident / incident is not defined and will be judged on its merits should a claim be lodged. The point is it must be serious enough for the injured persons Medical practitioner to consider that their condition is such that they warrant Specialist treatment and that has to be prescribed **within 72 hours of the incident occurring**.

The terms "Injury" and "Insured Person" are both defined in the Policy.
